in review

Below are highlights of our outreach & service ministries, with overviews, achievements, and outlooks. Additional details can be found in the pages to follow.

Community Outreach

We are committed to serving and supporting individuals and families in need through ongoing outreach efforts.

- <u>Drive-Thru Food Distribution</u>: Provides free groceries (non-perishables, produce, meats, and more) to an average of 200 individuals each month.
- Homeless Outreach: Delivers hot meals and essential items to 125+ individuals in the Dallas homeless community each month.

We are dedicated to expanding these programs in 2025 to reach even more families and better meet the needs of our community.

Senior Enrichment & Engagement

We cherish **all generations** in our church and community, ensuring our **seniors stay engaged**, **connected**, **and supported**.

- <u>Senior Expo</u>: Provided tickets & transportation to the <u>Dallas Arboretum</u> for <u>57 seniors</u> to access valuable <u>health</u>, <u>financial</u>, <u>and wellness</u> resources.
- <u>Lunch & Learn</u>: Attendees gained valuable insights on Medicare, ACA, free cell phone benefits, and primary care while networking over a delicious lunch, thanks to our partners.
- <u>Senior Prom</u>: Over 100 members dressed in their best black-tie attire for a night of elegance and fun & donated toys at the <u>Senior Prom</u> held at the <u>Shriner's Event Center</u>.

Looking ahead, we aim to expand resources for our 55+ community and strengthen intergenerational connections.

Health Initiatives

We actively build trust and relationships with the community while filling gaps in health and wellness access.

- Vision & Dental Clinics: Partnered with the Rowlett Lion's Club to offer free vision exams & free glasses, and partnered with Colgate to offer free oral health education, dental screenings, and treatment referrals.
- Mental Health Awareness: Metrocare Services shared valuable resources, tips, and career opportunities in recognition of Mental Health Awareness Month.
- Community Block Party & Wellness Fair:
 Connected 300+ attendees with 58 local vendors, exhibitors, and resources, while bringing neighbors together to enjoy music, food, games, and giveaways.

For 2025, we desire to support the community in achieving and restoring balance in body, mind, & spirit.

NextGen Empowerment

We are committed to nurturing and equipping the next generation with the tools they need to grow spiritually, academically, and as future leaders in our communities.

- Genesis Child Development Center: Provided daily child care to more than 100 children, ages 0-12, from both our church and the wider community.
- <u>Graduate Recognition</u>: ZBC honored our 2024 high school and college graduates, celebrating their achievements, and wishing them success in their next endeavors.

For 2025, our goal is to **strengthen faith-based leadership development opportunities** for youth and young adults.

Authentic Manhood Class

Brothers **ages 13 & up** meet every **2nd Saturday** for encouragement, wisdom, and discussion on faith and personal growth **(Genesis: God's expectation of a man)**

- Sessions feature heartfelt discussions, personal testimonies, and mentorship from elders
- A youth outing to see "The Forge" inspired ideas for building a fraternity of authentic men
 within ZBC and the broader community

Outreach Ministry

- Colgate Bright Smiles, Bright Future program brought their dental van and provided free
 oral care kits, dental health education, dental screenings, and referrals to local dentists
 for 24 children enrolled at Genesis CDC for a total in-kind of \$2,764.36 in goods & services
- Partnered with Life Line Screenings to provide essential health screenings where 60 participants received artery screenings to detect plaque buildup
- Breast Cancer Awareness Walk brought together survivors, fighters, and supporters. Evelyn
 Jones, a 22-year breast cancer survivor, delivered an inspiring message on early detection.
 Special thanks to Jonathan Mason of Stoneblack Media for capturing the moment.

- Pastor Griggs preached at Highland Baptist Church Terrell, TX, Family & Friends Day and at Cedar Grove Christian Church, Rowlett, TX for their 149th Church Anniversary

Yearly Events

- ZBC hosted an Easter Extravaganza event for over 75 children where the church and community enjoyed an egg hut, free food, fun games, and great fellowship
- Vacation Bible School hosted classes for all ages
- Rite of Passage to Manhood Ceremony held for Karon Cottrell's 21st birthday
- ZBC celebrated 162 years during our Church Anniversary
- Friends & Family Day welcomed guest for our annual celebration
- Discipleship Training Class & New Member Orientation resumed weekly on Thursdays

Safety & Security Team

- Incident Prevention & Response: The team successfully deterred at least 5 potential breakins, responding promptly to suspicious activity and ensuring the protection of church property.
- **Surveillance & Patrols**: Routine security patrols have strengthened overall security. Parking area monitoring and access control measures have improved safety.
- Facility & Asset Protection: The team coordinated maintenance and security upgrades, including improved lighting and camera system assessments to address vulnerabilities identified in the security self-assessment.

License to Carry (LTC) Training

ZBC hosted its first **LTC class** with **Gideon Training Solutions**, equipping participants with essential knowledge and skills for responsible firearm ownership.

- 16 individuals completed the course that included handgun use and safety, non-violent dispute resolution, safe storage practices, and laws related to weapons and the use of deadly force
- \$4,411.50 in in-kind donations for a security assessment, audit, and review of security protocols







Strengthening Our Impact Together

Zion Baptist Church is blessed to partner with incredible organizations that help us expand our reach and deepen our impact. Through these partnerships, we provide essential services, resources, and programs that uplift individuals and families in our community.

Interfaith & Service Partnerships



Collaborating across wards with the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, we provided over 200 meals monthly, distributed 250 holiday food baskets, and completed a multipurpose building clean-up project to serve the community better. Our partnership extends beyond service. We support each other's annual holiday events, and their members generously volunteered at our Community Block Party, strengthening our bond through shared commitment and compassion.

Each year, **Gideons International** and ZBC partner to **provide Bibles** to those who might otherwise go unreached, including prisoners, military personnel, and students. This global mission spans **nearly 200 countries**, touching countless lives with hope and faith.

Educational & Youth Partnerships

Our local community has been a vital partner in supporting the children and families of **Genesis Child Development Center**. Their generosity has provided faith-based enrichment through **Vacation Bible School**, **summer camp** experiences, essential **school supplies**, **holiday meal support**, and **Christmas gifts**—helping ensure that every child feels supported and valued throughout the year.




















Rowlett Lions Club
